Submitted stories should be within the specified word limit of 300-3,500.

Poetry can be in traditional, blank verse and free verse.

There is no age restriction for participating in the National Literary Congress of Shekarestan.

Each artist can submit a maximum of 3 works.

Priority will be given to unpublished poems and stories.

Selected works will be published as a book by the Congress Secretariat.

Each work should be submitted in a separate file.

Author's information should be provided at the end of each work on a separate page.

Participants must send their works to the Congress email address or through the mobile number of the Congress Secretariat and receive a confirmation of receipt.

Valuable prizes will be awarded to the selected works in each section by the jury.
